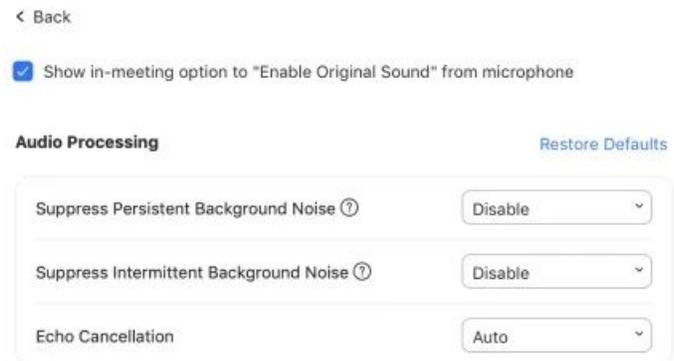


Optimize Audio Settings for Singing, Music Lessons, and Performance

Changing your Audio Setting during a Meeting

- 1) First, go to the audio settings via the arrow next to the 'Mute' button.
- 2) Untick 'Automatically Adjust Microphone Volume'
- 3) Just above that, adjust the 'Input Volume' slider to about 75%.
- 4) Go to 'Advanced' at the bottom of the setting page
- 5) Tick the box for "Show in-meeting option to "Enable Original Sound" from microphone". A detailed guide on Original Sound settings can be found [here](#).
- 6) Change both "Suppress Persistent Background Noise" and "Suppress Intermittent Background Noise" to disabled
- 7) Makes sure "Echo Cancellation" is set to auto
- 8) Be sure each of you choose "Turn on Original Sound" when you return to the meeting.
